90th GENEVA INTERNATIONAL MOTOR SHOW

PALEXPO. 5 - 15 MARCH 2020

The 90th Geneva International Motor Show will be held at Palexpo from 5 to 15 March 2020. It will be opened at 10 am on Thursday, 5 March by the Federal Councillor, Mr. Guy Parmelin, the State Council of the Republic and Canton of Geneva, Mrs Nathalie Fontanet, and the President of the Geneva International Motor Show, Mr Maurice Turrettini, in the presence of a host of politicians and personalities from the business community and the automotive industry.

CATEGORIES OF THE SHOW

Some **150 exhibitors** share a net exhibition area of almost $59'025 \text{ m}^2$ within a gross floor area of **106,000 m²**. GIMS Discovery is built on $10'500 \text{ m}^2$.

- > Road vehicles and complete chassis, electric vehicles and alternatively powered vehicles
- > Special bodywork for road vehicles, concept cars, refined cars and tuned cars
- > OEM (Original Equipment Manufacturers)-products of the industry suppliers
- Miscellaneous products and services related to the road mobility
- Animations / Attractions

PREMIERES AND INNOVATIONS

Manufacturers usually unveil major innovations at the Show, mostly in the presence of their top management. This year around **90 world and European premieres** have been announced and will be presented during the almost 67 announced press conferences.

CAR OF THE YEAR AWARD CEREMONY

The final vote plus the awarding of the prize "Car of the Year" will take place for the ninth time within the framework of the GIMS. The ceremony will occur on 2 March, 2020 at 3 pm, at the Palexpo's Congress Centre in room C. It is only for the accredited journalists but the general public can follow the proceedings by live streaming on www.gims.swiss and www.caroftheyear.org. The seven finalists are: BMW 1-Series, Ford Puma, Peugeot 208, Porsche Taycan, Renault Clio, Tesla Model 3, Toyota Corolla. These cars have a sales target of 5'000 units per year.

Currently, 60 journalists from 23 countries are members of the jury. The *Car of the Year* has been awarded since 1964 and was established by seven European magazines from seven countries: Germany *(Stern)*, Italy *(Auto)*, France *(L'Automobile)*, Spain *(Autopista)*, United Kingdom *(Autocar)*, The Netherlands *(Autovisie)* and Sweden *(Vi Bilägare)*.


By train

Avoid getting stuck in traffic jams and enjoy a comfortable, stress-free journey to the Motor Show. Palexpo Hall 7 is just a three minute walk away from Geneva Airport railway station.

By car

From Lausanne and France: take the motorway and follow the directions to "Palais des Expositions", Palexpo or Salon (Motor Show).

Parking facilities at Palexpo car park are only for exhibitors. However over 5.600 slots during the week and some 10.000 slots on the weekend will be made available exclusively for Motor Show visitors in 12 park decks located within 5 km radius around Palexpo (Flat rate: CHF 25.- per car) The Geneva police will manage the traffic in real time. The car parks are opened based on occupancy levels and the volume of traffic. Visitors are kindly requested to follow the "P°GIMS" signs.



Schedule of the shuttles: departure of the 1st shuttle one hour before the opening of the Motor Show, return of the last shuttle one hour after the closing of the Motor Show.

Neighbouring France

Possibility to park on the Vitam car park (ex Macumba). Shuttles provide a link to the Motor Show. Free parking. Fares are 4€ from 2 years old, 12€ from 12 years old.

Parking for disabled people

Parking spaces for disabled people are available in the Palexpo car park P12 and the outside car park P47. The number of parking spaces for disabled people is limited and can therefore not be guaranteed. Fees are payable

for disabled parking. The shuttle bus from/to P47 is equipped for persons with reduced mobility. Car Parks P12 and P47, price per car CHF 25.-.

Coaches

Car park P47 is reserved for coaches, buses and groups. Leave the motorway at exit Ferney and follow the signs. Daily rate: CHF 60.- (return transport of the passengers included)

FACILITIES INSIDE THE EXHIBITION BUILDING

- > Official information desks in the halls
- Cloakrooms: Congress centre (main entrance hall) from 3 until 15 March and entrances of Hall 5, from 5 to 15 March 2020, and Hall 7 entrance, from 4 to 15 March 2020.
- > Money: several cash withdrawal and exchange machines are available on-site halls
- ➤ Nursery: Congress Centre, Room L. For children aged 2 year 10 years. 1st hour free of charge, then CHF 6.- every following hour. A Fireman takes care of lost children and accompanies them to the nursery.
